

## Installing an Automated External Defibrillator

**Automated External Defibrillator:** to ensure as much continuity as possible across campus, MIT has two standard AEDs that we use, the Philips HeartStart FRx or the Zoll AED Plus.

**Vendor:** MIT has a vendor contract with <u>Life Support Systems</u>, who will provide the AED, the AED cabinet, and maintenance. Contact Bret Smith: 781-320-0030 (or 800-520-9635) or email <u>bsmith@lifesupportsystems.com</u>.

**Cost:** The total cost of the AED equipment is \$1,590(Philips) or \$1,480(Zoll), with the following breakdown:

Installation Process: the following steps must be completed to install an AED and AED cabinet:

- 1. Order the device through Life Support Systems they copy our office on any MIT-related purchases.
- 2. Upon arrival of the equipment, place a work order through <u>Facilities</u> to hang the AED cabinet in the desired location. The cabinet should be installed in public locations (ex: lobbies, near fire alarm panels, bathrooms, fire exits, or other emergency equipment). Note: to comply with the ADA, the cabinet MUST be mounted so that the bottom is 30" from the floor. A representative from our office can recommend specific AED locations for your office, by request.
- 3. Place the AED in the cabinet upon completion of steps 1-2.

**Training:** MIT Emergency Management, in collaboration with MIT EMS and MIT Medical, can provide a quick, 30-minute AED training to all interested personnel. A full, 3-hour CPR/AED class can also be scheduled, as desired.
